

Timeline for Nomination Petitions and Committee Reporting in a Recall Election

Nomination Petitions

Time Frame	Action
<p>Polling Place: Can be circulated first <u>business</u> day after the recall election is set by the governing body.</p> <p>Mail Ballot: Can be circulated beginning on the first <u>calendar</u> day after the election is set by the governing body</p>	<p>Polling Place Election: Candidates may begin circulating nomination petitions the first <u>business</u> day after the date the recall election is set by the governing body and must file the petition no later than 20 <u>calendar</u> days prior to the election. 31-4-504(4)(a)</p> <p>Mail Ballot Election: Candidates may begin circulating nomination petitions beginning on the first <u>calendar</u> day after the election is set by the governing body and must file the petition no later than 45 <u>calendar</u> days prior to the election. Candidates will have at least ten <u>calendar</u> days to circulate the petition. 31-4-504(4)(b)</p>

Issue Committees *(Purpose is to support or oppose the recall of any elected official)*

Time Frame	Action
<p>Register within 10 <u>calendar</u> days of accepting or making contributions or expenditures of \$200 or more</p> <p>Report within 15 <u>calendar</u> days of filing the committee registration; every 30 <u>calendar</u> days thereafter until the date the recall election has been established; 14 <u>calendar</u> before the recall election; 7 <u>calendar</u> days before the recall election; and, 30 <u>calendar</u> days after the recall election.</p>	<p>Any issue committee whose purpose is the recall of any elected official shall register with the City Clerk within ten <u>calendar</u> days of accepting or making contributions or expenditures in excess of two hundred dollars to support or oppose the recall. C.R.S. 1-45-108(6)</p> <p>Issue committee must file a report of contributions and expenditures with the City Clerk. C.R.S. 1-45-108(6)</p>

Candidate Committees *(Any person wishing to fill a vacancy created by a successful recall)*

Time Frame	Action
Before accepting or making any contributions	All candidate committees must register with the City Clerk before accepting or making any contributions, meeting the requirements of C.R.S. 1-45-108(3).
Report 14 <u>calendar</u> days before the recall election; 7 <u>calendar</u> days before the recall election; and, 30 <u>calendar</u> days after the recall election	Any candidate or candidate committee supporting any candidate, including an incumbent, in a recall election, shall file reports of contributions and expenditures with the City Clerk. C.R.S. 1-45-108(2.7)
