Hours/Shifts

This is a commitment through the winter months. Volunteers have 24-hours after a snowstorm to remove snow/ice from qualified resident's sidewalks and walkways. This includes weekdays and weekends.

Address:

Volunteers are paired with a resident in need within a 2-mile radius of their home address.

Qualifications:

- Interest in assisting low-income, senior and/or people with disabilities.
- Physically able to remove snow/ice from sidewalks and walkways 24-hours after a snow storm.
- Able to commit for the entire winter season.
- A desire to make a positive impact in the community.

Description:

The Snowbusters Program is the city of Thornton's volunteer snow removal program.

This program was initiated to help provide snow removal for low-income, disabled and senior residents who cannot otherwise arrange or afford their own snow removal. Snowbusters help make it possible for their neighbors to safely enter and exit their homes as well as receive their meals and medication deliveries.

Application and Selection Process:

Qualified applicants will be prompted to complete a background check and will receive information regarding their resident.
