Connect for Health is the official health insurance marketplace for Coloradans, providing:

- The only place where residents can apply for Premium Tax Credits and Cost-Sharing Reductions to lower the cost of private health insurance.
- Tools that allow customers to easily compare plans and prices from multiple insurance companies and search for preferred providers and medications.
- Qualified health plans, which include essential benefits and protections (in accordance with the Affordable Care Act).

Health First Colorado (Colorado Medicaid)

Health First Colorado is public health insurance for Coloradans who qualify. This coverage provides you three kinds of basic benefits:

- Physical health benefits
- Dental benefits
- Behavioral health (mental health and substance use benefits)

For some services, you may have a co-pay. A co-pay is a fixed amount you pay when you get a covered health care service. You never have to pay more than the co-pay for covered services.

Medicare

Medicare is our country's health insurance program for people age 65 or older. Certain people younger than age 65 can qualify for Medicare too, including those with disabilities and those who have permanent kidney failure. The program helps with the cost of health care, but it does not cover all medical expenses or the cost of most long-term care. You have choices for how you get Medicare coverage. If you choose to have Original Medicare (Part A and Part B) coverage, you can buy a Medicare Supplement Insurance (Medigap) policy from a private insurance company.

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS)

HCBS provides Medicaid sponsored services for elderly, physically handicapped, or blind adults who can be appropriately cared for in their own home, rather than a nursing home. Colorado Access is the Single Entry Point (SEP) designated agency for Adams County. Colorado Access determines the functional eligibility for participation in HCBS, while Human Services Department determines financial eligibility. Income and resource guidelines must be met. Special Low Income Medicare Beneficiary Program (SLMB)

SLMB pays for all or part of the Medicare (Part B) premiums for Medicare recipients with limited income and resources. Income and resource guidelines must be met.
