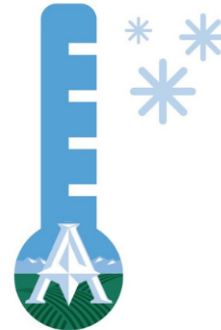


# SEVERE WEATHER activation plan



## WHAT IS SWAP?

The Adams County Severe Weather Activation Plan (SWAP) is a program that provides life-saving measures for people experiencing unsheltered homelessness. The assessment process may include referral to shelter, a hotel/motel stay, or severe weather supplies.

## WHO IS SWAP FOR?

SWAP serves people experiencing unsheltered homelessness in Adams County.

## WHEN IS SWAP ACTIVATED?

SWAP will activate when weather conditions reach 32°F and below and wet, and 20°F below and dry.

## WHERE CAN PEOPLE GO FOR SWAP SERVICES?

An in-person assessment is required. When SWAP is activated, people seeking services should visit the Anythink Library, 9417 Huron St. Thornton from 12:00 PM to 4:00 PM,
