

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE 2021 THORNTON ASSISTANCE FUNDS TO NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS THAT HELP THORNTON RESIDENTS MEET THEIR BASIC NEEDS AND ENHANCE THEIR ABILITY TO BE SELF-SUFFICIENT.

WHEREAS, the City authorized \$150,000 in the 2021 Budget to be distributed through the Thornton Assistance Funds program; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Thornton Assistance Funds is to support nonprofit organizations that assist Thornton residents with their basic needs and help them to become self-sufficient; and

WHEREAS, the City Council appointed a committee to thoroughly review the requests for funding and make a recommendation to City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the Committee's recommendation to give grants to the 19 identified nonprofit organizations for essential services that benefit residents of Thornton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THORNTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

That funds set aside for Thornton Assistance Funds are hereby awarded to the following organizations at the following amounts for 2021:
