Regional Transportation District

Currently, Thornton routes include 8, 12, 19, 80, 80L, 88L, 92, 93L, 104, 104L, 112, 120, 120L, 120X, and 122X. RTD Access-a-Ride

Local bus transportation in the Denver metro area for people with disabilities.

To qualify for Access-a-Ride, you must:

1. Be unable to get to and from a bus stop or on and off a lift-equipped fixed-route bus by yourself.
2. Have a disability that prohibits you from completing fixed-route bus independently.

RTD FlexRide
