

Entering & Parking at the Event...



RV PARKING Recreational vehicles (RVs) are no longer allowed at this event.

GENERAL PARKING OFF OF 108TH AVENUE The majority of the available parking is on the south side of the site; both paved lots (east lot is reserved for ADA parking) and the overflow area are accessed via 108th Avenue, west of Colorado Boulevard.

ADA PARKING The eastern-most paved parking lot directly south of the event field is reserved for ADA parking and is accessed via 108th Avenue west of Colorado Boulevard.

CARPENTER RECREATION CENTER PARKING LOT & CARPENTER PARK UPPER PARKING LOT These two paved parking lots can be accessed by using the entrance at 110th Place and Colorado Boulevard.

SURROUNDING NEIGHBORHOODS Do not block driveways, park in fire lanes or block fire hydrants and please be courteous of homeowners.

WALKERS & CYCLISTS There is a pedestrian underpass under Colorado Boulevard just south of 110th Place that allows pedestrians to enter the event safely.

RTD N-LINE Hop aboard the RTD N-Line and ride to the 104th Avenue or 112th Avenue station, just short walking distances to Carpenter Park Fields. For a complete southbound and northbound holiday schedule, visit rtd-denver.com/app/route/N.

IMPORTANT COLORADO BOULEVARD CLOSURE INFORMATION!

As parking lots surrounding Carpenter Park Fields fill-up, stages of Colorado Boulevard will be shut down, beginning with the section of Colorado Boulevard between 108th and 112th Avenues. This section of Colorado Blvd. is anticipated to close at 8 p.m. but could possibly close sooner pending the level of pedestrian and vehicular traffic.

During the fireworks and during the exit of the event, Colorado Boulevard between 104th and 120th Avenues will be closed to all non-event thru traffic until approximately 11:15 p.m.

Exiting the Event...



COLORADO BOULEVARD 104TH-120TH AVENUES

Closed except for vehicles exiting the event. No vehicular traffic on Colorado Boulevard, between 108th Avenue and 112th Avenue.

ADA/GENERAL PARKING OFF OF 108TH AVENUE

Cars in paved lots and dirt overflow lots will be sent south on Colorado Boulevard to 104th Avenue.

CARPENTER RECREATION CENTER PARKING LOT & CARPENTER PARK UPPER PARKING LOT

Sent north along the park road (Kiehl Way) to exit 112th Avenue and Madison Street where you will be sent east on 112th Avenue and then north on Colorado Boulevard.

WALKERS & CYCLISTS

Walk and/or ride across Colorado Boulevard between 108th Avenue and 112th Avenue as all vehicle traffic will be diverted other directions until approximately 10:45 p.m.
