The board recommends goals and policies; maintains donations and bequests; sponsors fund raising events; applies for and accepts awards, grants, funds, or cultural benefits on behalf of TASHCO; acts as a service and advocacy body for the arts, sciences, and humanities; disperses funds to carry out the purposes authorized in the approved budget; develops an Arts and Culture Master Plan; and authorizes the purchase and placement of public artwork provided in the approved budget.
