Temporary Outdoor Dining Operational Guidelines

- The business/operator is responsible for obtaining all other City, County, and State permits necessary to operate the business.
- Parking and/or hard surface areas, excluding landscaping, are eligible areas for Temporary Outdoor Dining. No more than 50-percent of the required parking spaces associated with the subject Restaurant/Bar/Tavern shall be utilized for temporary outdoor dining.
- The business/operator shall ensure that all temporary outdoor dining areas are clearly demarcated with stanchions or similar appurtenances.
- The business/operator shall ensure that all temporary outdoor dining areas are separated from active parking and drive aisles a minimum of two (2) feet.
- The business/operator shall ensure that all pedestrian and vehicular circulation routes are not impacted or blocked in any manner by the area(s) utilized for temporary outdoor dining.
- The business/operator shall ensure that all emergency service access, site ingress/egress, and ADA accessible routes are not impacted or blocked in any manner by area(s) utilized for temporary outdoor dining.
- The business/operator shall ensure that signage is clear and present for patrons to navigate parking and/or temporary outdoor dining areas.
- The business/operator shall ensure that patrons are adequately separated in compliance with CDC and/or Colorado Public Health and Environment guidelines.
- If used in the temporary outdoor dining area, the business/operator shall ensure proper installation and security of patio umbrellas so as not to constitute a hazard to people, traffic, or private property.
- When applicable, the business/operator shall ensure reasonable lighting of the temporary outdoor dining area for evening/night operations to ensure the safety of patrons without disrupting traffic or other uses in the vicinity.
- The business/operator shall obtain all required city permits for any shade structures or tents.
- All structures and materials associated with the temporary outdoor dining shall be removed within twenty four hours of notification that the temporary approval has expired or has been revoked. The site shall be cleaned, all evidence of its use removed, and left in a condition that minimizes adverse impacts to the site itself and to surrounding properties.
