



CHECK YOUR PLATE, MAKE SURE IT'S UP TO DATE!

After a pause during the pandemic, Thornton Code Compliance will again begin enforcement of unlawful vehicles on private property and in city of Thornton rights-of-way.

Any vehicle or recreational vehicle that does not display current and up-to-date license plates, in city right-of-way, or on private property; unless stored in a garage, can be subject to be towed after a 72-hour Tow Warning notice or blight hearing process.
