Need help getting groceries?

Food stamps, federally known as the Supplemental Food Assistance Program (SNAP), provides families and individuals with financial resources to purchase groceries. Those eligible for benefits can include families, children, individuals, elderly, immigrants, refugees, asylees, disabled individuals, the unemployed and underemployed as well as those experiencing homelessness.

To find out if you qualify and to apply for any federal nutrition assistance program call the statewide, bilingual food resource hotline toll-free at 855-855-4626 by Hunger Free Colorado.

Online Purchasing and Delivery – SNAP beneficiaries can now order groceries online through Amazon and Walmart. Additional retailers, like King Soopers, are offering online ordering for curbside pick-up with an EBT card. When placing your pickup order,



go to Payment Option and choose “SNAP EBT at Pickup.” At this time, WIC is not currently accepted. Please see the grocer’s websites or call them for more information. Call in service not available.

Drive Thru-Food Banks

- **Food Bank of the Rockies Mobile Pantry:** Open on the third Thursday of every month in a drive-thru setting at 9065 Grant St. in the parking lot on the northwest corner of Grant Street and Russell Boulevard. Distribution begins 1 p.m. and ends when all the food is distributed, usually in about an hour. Arriving no later than 1:30 p.m. is recommended.
- **Senior Hub Food Bank:** Serves our senior community. Open Monday-Friday by APPOINTMENT ONLY from 9 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Call to make an appointment at 303-426-4408. They also have Senior Food Boxes (CSFP) and will come outside to your car.
- **Growing Home Food Bank:** Available Monday-Saturday, 10 a.m.-12 p.m. the Food Pantry hold distribution at the MAC Recreation Center at 3295 W. 72nd Ave. Please call 303-426-0430 for the latest information. They will come outside and place a prepackaged box in your car.
- **Chapel Hill Church in Brighton:** Located at 10 Chapel Hill Dr., Brighton. One box of food per family will be available on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month, as well as alternating Saturdays. On Wednesdays, food is available from 4-5:30 p.m. On Saturdays, please arrive promptly at 9:30 a.m., and food will be given out until 10 a.m. For the most up-to-date information, please call 720-685-7894. Volunteers will meet you in the parking lot to take your photo ID and check you in while you remain in your car. During the check-in, a volunteer will load your car with a box of food. Please stay in the line of cars and in your vehicle.
- **Community Baptist Church:** Located at 15559 Weld County Rd 2, Brighton. Every Tuesday, 11:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m. No ID required. They will have a drive-up distribution until social distancing is no longer required. Call 303-659-6487 for the latest information.

Home Delivered Food Services

- **Meals on Wheels:** Provides delivered meals to homebound adults who qualify based on income. Generally, programs serve adults 60 and over, although age requirements can vary by program and areas served.

- **Grocery delivery service now available to RTD Access-a-Ride customers.**
 - » Home grocery delivery service is available to all of the Regional Transportation District (RTD)'s Access-a-Ride customers. RTD is offering this service during the COVID-19 state of emergency to provide current Access-a-Ride customers with a food delivery option that does not require leaving home. No fare is required for customers to use this service.
- **Tri-County Health Department:** Residents who test positive for COVID-19 or have been in close contact with someone that has COVID and must quarantine, can seek food delivery resources from Tri-County's Community Service Branch.
