NEIGHBORHOOD CLEAN-UP

The CodeCAP Neighborhood Clean-Up program helps residents in a selected Thornton area by providing one-time yard maintenance. Neighborhood selection is determined in collaboration with the city of Thornton's Code Compliance division based on the neighborhood, frequency and type of violations, and resident need. CodeCAP partners with various organizations to recruit volunteers to complete the work. Thornton Parks and Adams County provides access to yard maintenance equipment and tools through their Tool Shed program.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NEIGHBORHOOD CLEAN-UP PROGRAM

- Be on site during the work period.
- Yard must be accessible and cleared of trash/debris.
- Have access to electrical outlets for plugging in electrical equipment.
- Access to driveway. Parking of equipment may be necessary.
- Keep pets indoors and away from the work crew.
- Observe the work crew, if physically able.
- Do not use alcohol or any illegal substance on the day of the project.
- Be aware that some projects might not be completed, or may be cancelled or rescheduled due to insufficient manpower, weather conditions, etc.
- Resident is responsible for disposing of trash/debris collected during the clean-up utilizing their regular waste management services.
- Resident understands that the Neighborhood Clean-Up is a one-time service. Continuing yard maintenance service **WILL NOT** be provided by CodeCAP, and it is the responsibility of the resident.

NEIGHBORHOOD CLEAN-UP PROCESS

1. Apply to receive services by Wednesday, April 15, 20256 by 5:00 pm.
2. The CodeCAP Coordinator will contact you to schedule a yard visit.
3. The CodeCAP Coordinator will notify you if your application has been approved.
If approved, your home will be added to the list of projects for the Neighborhood Clean-Up date.
If not approved, other resources for other available services will be provided.

Applications are accepted, reviewed and approved by Thornton's CodeCAP program:
