In 2024, the city of Thornton spent **\$1,185,665** in CDBG funds to serve **10,655** residents and households.

LMI Area Park Improvements

McAllister Park at 750 W. 96th Avenue, used CDBG funds for design. The design for the park renovations include tree-lined walkways that are ADA compliant, log and rock climbing areas, a splash pad, community gardens, and an area for a public art installation. This park serves 5,525 residents. Total spent: **\$53,022**.

Loma Linda Park at 351 E. 99th Place, used CDBG funds for new playground equipment, safety surfaces, ADA pathways, a music area, bike racks, and seating. This park serves 715 residents. Total spent: **\$300,000**.

Sidewalk Safety and ADA Accessibility Project - The 100th Avenue and Riverdale Road design, engineering and right-of-way obtainment project continued in 2024. This project hurdled numerous barriers and finished the design, engineering and ROW obtainment. The city spent the last **\$5,607** of the \$103,959 total project cost to complete the project. The construction phase will on June 9, 2025 using CDBG funding and when finished will benefit 3,380 residents.

The city of Thornton was awarded **\$803,023** in Program Year 2024, which was a 4% decrease from the previous year.
