



Youth Firesetter Program

If your child engages in firesetting, even in small incidents, early intervention can prevent serious harm.

Warning Signs:

- Children over 10 can face criminal charges; those over 14 may be charged as adults.
- Parents may be financially liable for damages.
- Firesetting often indicates emotional issues, especially in boys.
- Early intervention can reduce repeat behavior to under 1%.

Program Details:

- The program is free with parent referral.
- A fee applies if a child aged 10 or older receives a citation for firesetting.

Every fire started by a child is significant no matter the size or how much it destroys. Please ask for assistance for a child starting fires as early as possible.
