A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING COUNCILMEMBER ANGIE BEDOLLA FOR HER LEADERSHIP AND CONTRIBUTIONS AS A WARD 4 COUNCILMEMBER FOR THE CITY OF THORNTON.

WHEREAS, Councilmember Angie Bedolla was sworn in as a Ward 4 Councilmember on February 4, 2020; and

WHEREAS, during her tenure, Councilmember Bedolla served on the City Council Ad Hoc Committee on equity from June 2020 to September 2021, which focused on topics of communication, technology, transportation, amenities, and police oversight; and

WHEREAS, during her service on Council, the COVID-19 pandemic had the potential to bring devastation to the community's health, safety, and economic status; however, with the allocation of Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act funding, Councilmember Bedolla contributed to discussions and supported actions that helped keep businesses open and community members safe, such as the opening of the Thornton Business Assistance Center; business grant programs; food, housing, and mental health support; and COVID-19 testing; and


