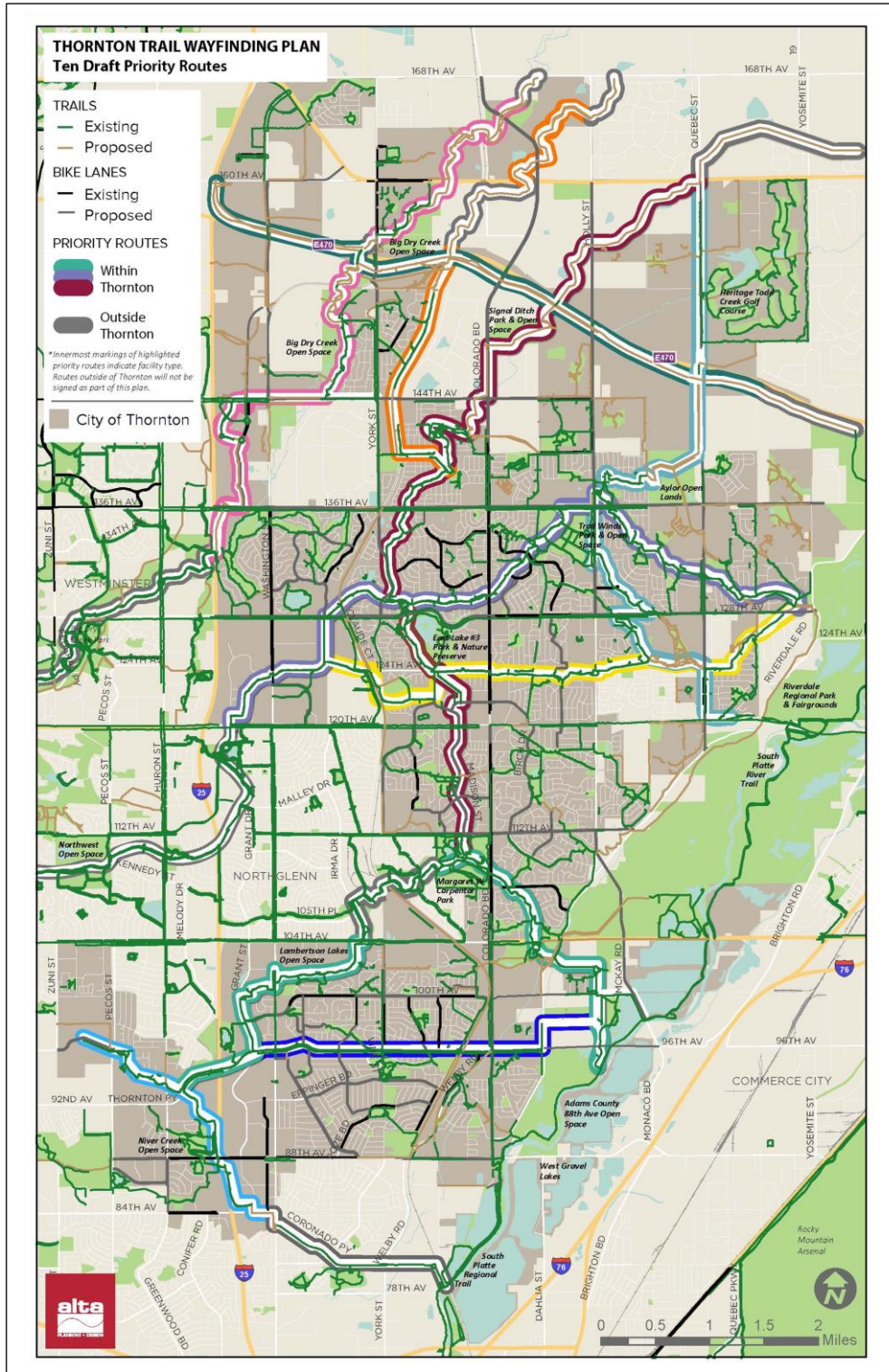


Thornton Trail Wayfinding Signage Project

The goal of this Trail Wayfinding Signage Project is to help trail users easily navigate the city's trails system and reliably access key destinations throughout the city and beyond. We are working with a planning & design consultant firm and have reviewed the results with a city staff team during different development phases of the project. We then presented the project at multiple meetings with the Parks & Open Space Advisory Board and have received project approval on the following items:

1. Citywide prioritized color coded route system.



2. Selection of a sign family design concept
