

Festuca glauca

Blue Fescue



This blue-grey grass has thin delicate leaf blades and is great as an accent planting in the foreground and borders of xeric gardens. Looks good when several are planted together in geometric shapes or distinct patterns. The grass is very drought tolerant and needs well draining soil. If over watered the roots will rot out and the plant will die. Divide every few years to maintain tight clumping and vigorous growth. Full sun.
