AQUILEGIA CHRYSANTHA YELLOW COLUMBINE



This popular southwestern native has long pale yellow sepals with gold petals. Abundant delicate foliage provides a vivid green background. An ideal plant for brightening shady woodland areas. The genus name is derived from the Latin word for eagle, which alludes to the spurs that resemble their talons. Plant in part shade, well draining soil, low water once established. Keep deadheaded, seeds are viable so it will spread.
