



Lonicera reticulate Kintzley's Ghost® Vining Honeysuckle



This plant select winner of 2006 is a very unique specimen. First propagated in the 1880's by William "Ped" Kintzley at Iowa State University, then passed to family members .It was rediscovered growing in Ft. Collins, Colorado. Round eucalyptus like leaves produce attractive yellow flowers in the center, followed by a red berry in late summer. Tolerates most soil types, and grows 8-12 feet tall. Full sun to part shade. Enjoys moderate water.
