Caragana arborescens

Do you have a spot where nothing will grow? Give the Caragana a try. This is a large shrub that grows in an upright almost columnar shape. It is typically multi-stemmed and generally will not have branches or foliage at the base of the stems. It produces small peas like flower which form a seed pod that will change from green to tan in July or August.

Being a member of the legume family this is a nitrogen fixing plant. It is tolerant of many adverse growing conditions. It is drought resistant and tolerates soils with salts. It can be used as a hedge, screen, or windbreak, and is good as bird habitat.
