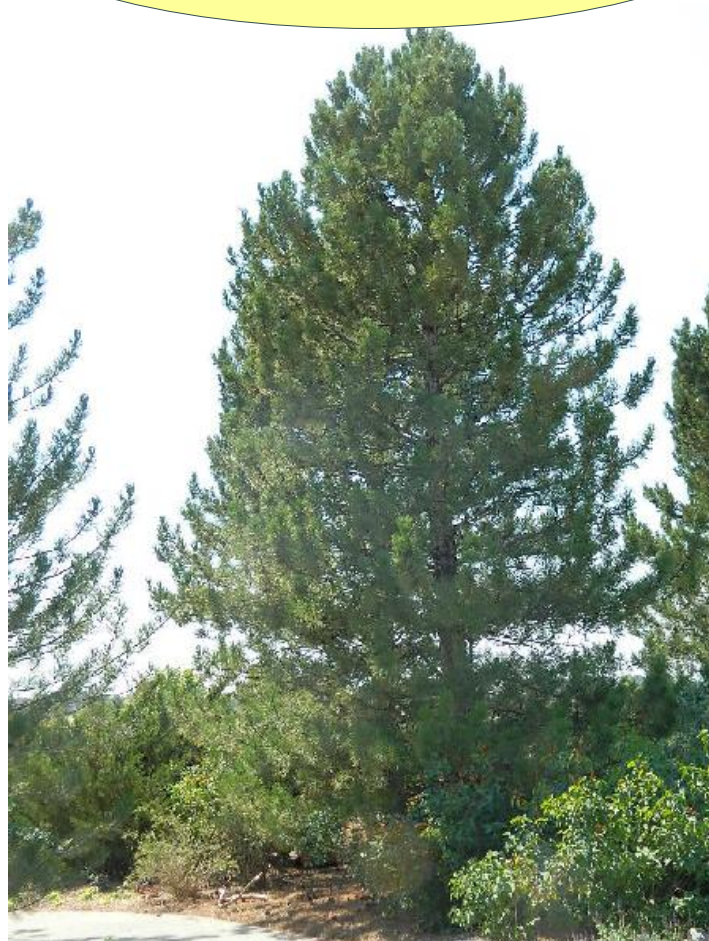


Austrian Pine

Pinus nigra

Height: 40'-60'
Width: 25'-40'
(At Maturity)
Growth/Yr: 12-18"
USDA Zone: 4-7
Cone: 2"-3"
Sun: Full Sun
Water: Low



This large growing pine has dark green rigid needles. It is extremely hardy and does well withstanding urban conditions, and tolerates many soil types. Make sure it has room to grow. It 's thick horizontal branches make it a wonderful specimen as well as a good screening tree.

Be aware of winter desiccation on all evergreen trees. This is when outer needles turn brown because of moisture loss. Winter watering is recommended for young trees. You will want to give them 10 gallons per caliper inch per month.
