A stately oak which tolerates a wide range of soil pH and moisture conditions. It has a natural branch habit which requires little if any pruning to create good form and strong structure. It is generally pest free and in general is an low maintenance tree. It will produce an acorn that approximate 1 to 3 inches long but it may take up to 25 years before the tree will bear them. In the Fall its leaves are Copper in color and can be persistent through the winter. This tree is Drought tolerant.
